

ABS

Characteristics, use and maintenance



The material

ABS is a common thermoplastic polymer used to create light and rigid objects, it is a very resistant plastic and does not corrode easily, it is a non-toxic material (so much so that can also be used in children's toys), therefore ideal for showers and hoses.



Ordinary cleaning

For the daily maintenance of ABS products it is necessary to regularly clean the surface after use to avoid the accumulation of dirt and limescale, for cleaning use warm water and soap or common detergents to remove most of the dirt and stains that can form on the surface.



How to prevent damages

To prevent stubborn stains, do not leave soap or shampoo residue on the surface, prolonged contact may stain the material. Do not place lit cigarettes or flames that could irreversibly damage the material.

Some chemical-based substances, normally used for personal hygiene and cleaning, such as: acetone, paint removers, bleach, perfumes, aftershave or very aggressive disinfectants can damage the ABS, so it is necessary not to leave residues on the surface.

Do not use powdered cleaning products that need to be scrubbed on the surface.

Rinse several times with warm water and a soft cloth. To restore the original effect, use a wet cloth and a gentle abrasive cream over the entire surface with circular movements.

If there are any traces of limescale around the drain pipe or near the taps, use a non-abrasive sponge and a normal cleaning product, then rinse with hot water and dry with a soft cloth.
